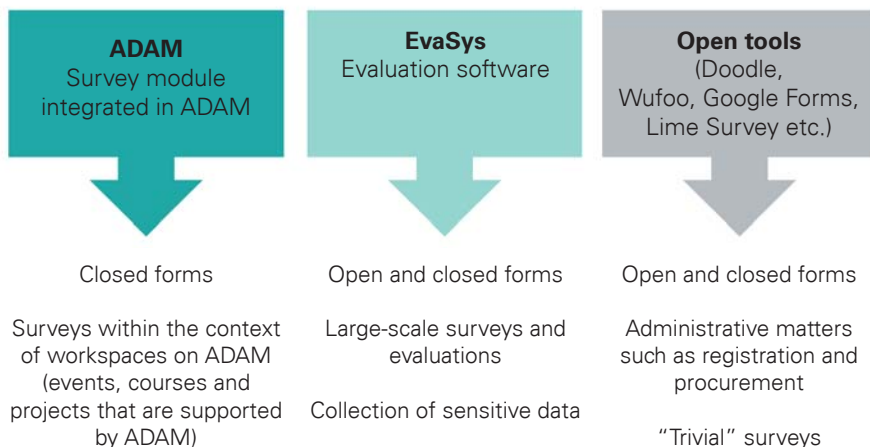

Online Surveys

Preparing and Evaluating.

Online survey systems enable you to easily prepare and administer form-based surveys and evaluate the results. Depending on the tool employed, the systems, which are administered solely via the browser, facilitate both open surveys that can be filled in anonymously by any person having access to the link, and personalised (closed) forms that can only be accessed once by a group of authorised users. In both cases the survey is conducted and evaluated in anonymised form.



Online surveys

Online surveys can be used in many different ways, for example when making preliminary enquiries regarding the organisation or content preparation of a course, when conducting opinion polls or competitions, and for studies or evaluations of courses. Depending on the requirement, different tools are available:

Survey module integrated in ADAM

A function for preparing surveys and evaluations integrated in ADAM is available to all employees.

EvaSys evaluation software

The professional EvaSys evaluation tool is already used for evaluating courses at the University of Basel. This online survey system is suitable for securely conducting large-scale surveys and evaluations. EvaSys is not suitable for administrative matters such as application or order forms.

Open tools

Various open tools (Doodle, Wufoo, Google Forms, Lime Survey) lend themselves to administrative and low-threshold surveys or searches for dates. Online forms of open tools can be integrated into websites using 'iframe' (the form appears on the website). Open tools should not be used to collect sensitive data.
